**JUDICIAL COURTS SUSPEND WORK AS A PREVENTIVE  
MEASURE IN VIEW OF THE CURRENT CRISIS OF COVID-19**



**April 3, 2020**

As a result of Covid-19 pandemic, the following judicial courts, with the general exception of criminal and family courts and until today, have suspended their work:

### **I. ANNOUNCEMENTS OF WORK SUSPENSION AT A FEDERAL LEVEL:**

#### **National Supreme Court of Justice**

Through announcement number 56/2020, dated March 17, 2020, the National Supreme Court of Justice decreed the suspension of work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no meetings, hearings or procedural deadlines will be held. There will be only one guard to receive urgent constitutional disputes requesting precautionary measures.

#### **Federal Judicial Authority**

Through announcement number 12/2020, dated March 17, 2020, the Federal Judicial Authority ordered the suspension of work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above there will be no procedural deadlines and there will only be a guard for matters requiring urgent attention.

#### **Federal Court of Administrative Justice**

By means of announcement number 5/2020 dated 17 March, 2020, the Federal Court of Administrative Justice ordered that work be suspended from 18 March to 19 April 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **II. ANNOUNCEMENTS OF WORK SUSPENSION AT A LOCAL LEVEL:**

#### **Mexico City's Judicial Authority**

Through announcement V-16/2020, dated March 1, 2020, Mexico City's Superior Court of Justice ordered the extension of the suspension of jurisdictional work, which began on March 18, 2020 and will continue until April 30, 2020. Jurisdictional work resumes on May 4, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Administrative Justice Court of Mexico City**

By announcement dated March 17, 2020, the Administrative Justice Court of Mexico City ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 17, 2020.

By means of a decree dated March 24, 2020, the Administrative Justice Court of Mexico City ordered the suspension of the guard established in the agreement dated March 17, 2020, taking effect on March 25 of this year.

### **State of Mexico's Judicial Authority**

Through decree number 19/2020, dated March 31, 2020, the State of Mexico's Judicial Authority ordered the extension of the suspension of jurisdictional work, which began on March 20, 2020 and will continue until April 30, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Nuevo León State Judicial Authority**

By means of the general announcement number 6/2020-II, dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Nuevo León, ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Jalisco State Judicial Authority**

By announcement dated 17 March 2020, suspension of work was ordered from 18 March to 3 April 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Aguascalientes State Judicial Authority**

In the extraordinary session 02/Plenos/2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Aguascalientes ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to 31, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Baja California State Judicial Authority**

By extraordinary session, the Judicial Authority of the State of Baja California ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Baja California Sur State Judicial Authority**

As of March 25, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Baja California Sur has not suspended work.

A statement was issued inviting all citizens and trial lawyers to make use of the Electronic Court to reduce the number of visitors to courts and tribunals.

### **Campeche State Judicial Authority**

Through a announcement dated March 20, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Campeche determined the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 23 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Chiapas State Judicial Authority**

Through announcement number 15 of the year 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Chiapas ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Chihuahua State Judicial Authority**

By announcement dated 17 March 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Chihuahua ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from 18 March to 19 April 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Coahuila State Judicial Authority**

In an official statement, the Judicial Authority of the State of Coahuila ordered the suspension of jurisdictional activities from March 19 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Colima State Judicial Authority**

Through announcement number 20 of the year 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Colima ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to April 17, 2020.

By announcement dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Durango ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

### **Guanajuato State Judicial Authority**

At session held on March 19, 2020, the Council of the Judicial Authority of the State of Guanajuato ordered that work be suspended from March 21 to April 19, 2020.

### **Guerrero State Judicial Authority**

Through announcement 08/2020, dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Guerrero ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Hidalgo State Judicial Authority**

Through announcement 02/2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Hidalgo ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to April 8, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

**Michoacán State Judicial Authority**

By an official statement dated March 18, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Michoacán ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to April 19, 2020.

Through announcement 08/2020, dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Morelos ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

**Nayarit State Judicial Authority**

In an official announcement dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Nayarit ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

**Oaxaca State Judicial Authority**

**Puebla State Judicial Authority**

By an official announcement dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Puebla ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 20, 2020.

During the period mentioned above, no procedural deadlines will apply.

### **Querétaro State Judicial Authority**

Through General Agreement 4/2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of Quintana Roo ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 19 to April 19, 2020.

### **San Luis Potosí State Judicial Authority**

Through announcement 16/2020, dated March 17, 2020, the Judicial Authority of the State of San Luis Potosi ordered the suspension of jurisdictional work from March 18 to April 19, 2020.

### **Sinaloa State Judicial Authority**

**Yucatan State Judicial Authority**
