ELECTRICITY SECTOR IN MEXICO EXTENDS SUSPENSION PERIOD

May 11, 2020

THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY, THE NATIONAL ENERGY CONTROL CENTER AND THE ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION EXTEND SUSPENSION OF THE TERMS AND DEADLINES

As a continuation of the measures ordered by Mexico's General Health Council and Ministry of Health to prevent and combat the spread of the Coronavirus Covid-19, on April 30, 2020, the Ministry of Energy ("SENER"), the National Energy Control Center ("CENACE") and the Energy Regulatory Commission ("CRE") published resolutions in the Federal Official Gazette, whereby the suspension of the terms and deadlines of the acts and procedures carried out before such government authorities that was previously ordered, is to be extended until May 30, 2020 (the "Resolutions").

Considering that May 31st is not a business day, the foregoing implies that: (i) the terms and deadlines of the proceedings handled by SENER, CENACE and CRE will be suspended until May 31st, 2020 and will resume on June 1, 2020; (ii) the compliance of periodic obligations before SENER, CENACE and CRE will be suspended until May 31st, 2020, and will resume on June 1st, 2020; and (iii) the requests and applications submitted to SENER, CENACE and CRE during the suspension period will be deemed as filed on June 1st, 2020 (and consequently, the term for their resolution will commence as of such date).
